BRIEF HISTORY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF GEOGRAPHY

- ❖ Study of geography in Bosnia and Herzegovina has emerged with establishment of Sub-department of Geography at the Faculty of Philosophy in 1950.
- ❖ With the establishment of the Faculty of Science in Sarajevo, as a separate education and scientific institution in 1960, the Department of Geography has grown into the Department of Geography, as the most relevant higher education institution in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

STUDY COURSES

Three very attractive courses are organized at the Department of Geography:

- Geography in Education
- Regional and Spatial Planning
- Tourism and Environmental Protection

Studies and also organized on three levels – 1st cycle, 2nd cycle and 3rd cycle – doctoral study

NOTES FOR FUTURE STUDENTS:

- ❖ No entrance exam
- ❖ Final score on the entrance list is based on high school grade point average, the grades from the following subjects: Geography, mother language, first foreign language, Mathematics, as well as school competition results
- ❖ Fourth-year students do an internship that is relevant to their study courses, getting work experience and CV enrichment in that way
- ❖ Student practice is usually done in schools, various institutions, airline companies, travel agencies, institutes, spatial planning organizations etc.
- ❖ Some students also got an employment in the places where they used to do an internship

THERE ARE THREE STUDYING STATUSES:

- ❖ Full-time students
- ❖ Full-time self-financing students
- ❖ Part-time students (they are required to attend 30% of education process – it is organized in three terms during semester)

STUDY PRICE PER YEAR:

- ❖ FULL-TIME STUDENTS: 100 KM
- ❖ FULL-TIME SELF-FINANCING STUDENTS: 1200 KM (payment is possible in two installments)
- ❖ PART-TIME STUDENTS: 900 KM (payment is possible in two installments)

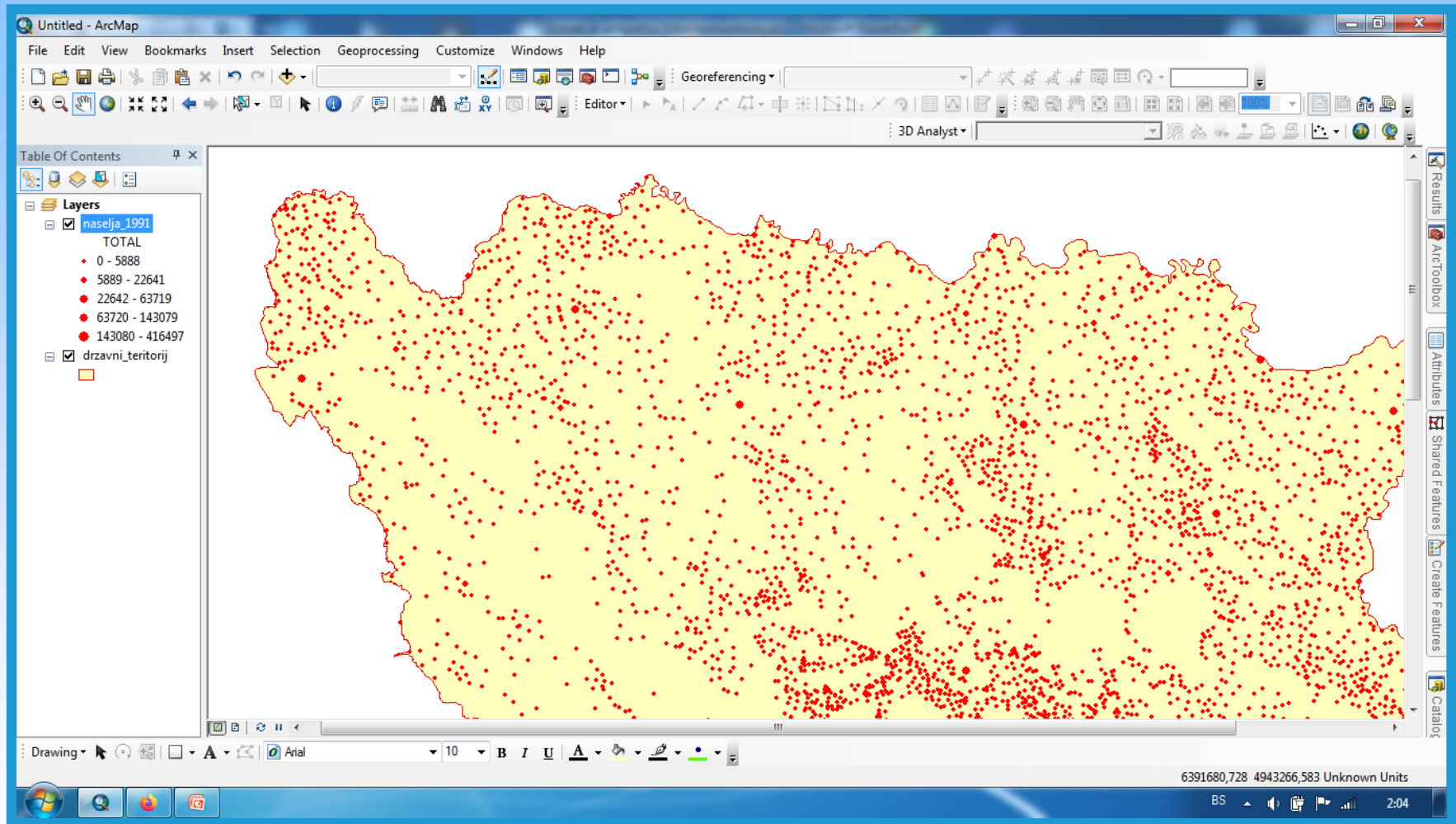
CABINETS AND EQUIPMENT

- ❖ employees in government institutions in charged for planning and organization of education, from municipal to national.

Graduates of the course **Regional and Spatial Planning** can work in:

- ❖ government institutions incharged for regional and spatial planning;
- ❖ regional development agencies;
- ❖ scientific research institutes incharged for regional and spatial planning
- ❖ private companies and organizations that deals with preparations of elaborates, spatial plans, maps etc.;
- ❖ education organizations in the field of GIS technology.

WHERE TO FIND AN EMPLOYMENT?

Graduates of the course **Tourism and Environmental Protection** can work in:

- ❖ government institutions incharged for tourism;
- ❖ travel agencies and airline companies;
- ❖ private organizations that deal with tourism master plans and elaborates for protected natural areas;
- ❖ consulting agencies for tourism development and environmental protection;
- ❖ scientific institutes incharged for tourism development planning;
- ❖ scientific institutes incharged for environmental protection;
- ❖ non-governmental organizations in the field of environmental protection.
