Subject objectives:	Enabling students to understand the causes of geoecological imbalances and their consequences at the local and global level. Understanding the essence of natural and anthropogenic impacts on the environment, defining the quality, sources of pollution of the geocomplex and directions of protection through knowledge of the current environmental protection legislation in Bosnia and Herzegovina.		
Teaching units:	1. Geoecological imbalances and consequences (introductory lecture); 2. Human population growth and the environment, regional differences in the demographic explosion; 3. Natural and social geographic conditions of population growth; 4. Urbanization and the environment, basic and contemporary trends of urbanization and the environment; 5. Rural systems and the environment. The impact of agriculture on the environment; 6. The influence of industry on the quality of the environment; 7. Partial exam; 8. The impact of the use of energy resources on the quality of the environment; 9. Atmospheric complex - sources of pollution, temperature inversions; 10. Local and global effects of atmospheric pollution and ways of protection; 11. Hydrospheric complex - pollution sources, water supplies and consumption; 12. Determination of the quality and directions of protection of the hydrospheric geocomplex;		



	13. Pedosphere complex - genesis, endangerment and directions of protection 14. Biosphere complex - endangerment and ways of protection; 15. Legal regulation of environmental protection in Bosnia and Herzegovina.
